**DISCIPLE REFLECTIONS**

After 24 weeks of study, reading and participation the Disciple Fast Track program is ending. Over the time we have had 65 people participate in four different groups. Not all were able to complete both the Old and New Testaments. This has involved 40 hours of face to face meeting, 600 hours of reading Scripture and completing the weekly reading in the manual, and prayer time. All this for a course that was designed for busy people!!! The course has been challenging, inspiring, disturbing and educational. Participants now have a much deeper understanding of the connection between the Old and New Testaments.

Here are some comments from participants:

*Participating in Disciple Fast Track has given us a fresh way to engage with the bible, that has both challenged us and opened our eyes to a new understanding of the context and interpretation of the Bible. The small group discussions under Rev Clive's guidance have been a spiritually nourishing and rewarding journey with fellow travellers!*

*Srian and Kumi - I have learnt how important the Old Testament is because the prophesies from the Old Testament become reality in the New Testament.*

*Ann - I think the overview of the Scriptures and the whole story was most valuable, and the way participants got to know and appreciate one another at a whole new level.*

*Clive - I've found Disciple Fast Track to be an engaging and very helpful study. The readings are well structured and provide an excellent whole picture of the Old and New Testaments. I've enjoyed meeting with our group to discuss our learnings and hearing the insights of others. I am very glad I participated in this study and I'm sure I will continue to refer back to the study notes for many years to come.*

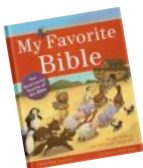

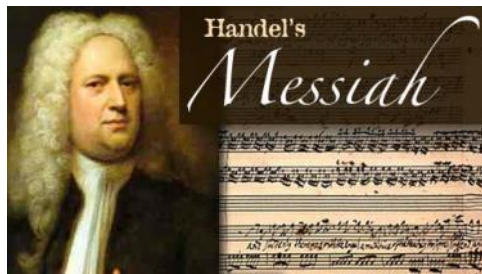
