Spiritual Leadership

Spiritual Leadership is not a term I'm comfortable with. The scriptures don't use the word *Leadership* to denote a person who shows the way or helps others to discern God's purposes in their life. They use the word *discipleship*. Part of being a disciple is making other disciples – this requires living by example and unfolding the meaning of Jesus' teachings in our everyday lives. The term *spiritual leadership* has become synonymous with using our gifts and graces to provide vision, direction and purposefulness in our experience of Christian community.

The Uniting Church has a particular way of viewing *spiritual leadership* that encourages people to participate in God's work in the church and in the world. It is focused on being relational not transactional, communal not individual and collaborative not authoritative. The nature of this leadership requires good personal skills in relating to others and good team building skills to help the body of Christ to work together. Leaders of a Uniting Church congregation have the responsibility, according to the Basis of Union para 15b to:

Build up the congregation in faith and love

Sustain members in hope

Lead members into a fuller participation in Christ's mission in the world.



In 2015 the CKCC congregation completed a discernment process to answer the question: 'How can we be God's people in our region throughout the next 5 years?'

The process identified 4 Key Discernments in looking forward:

- Continue the development of an Inter-generational Focus at CKCC
- Continue to affirm and nurture good things already happening at CKCC
- Develop more ways of reaching out into our community
- Work on strategies to fill missing 'gaps' in the demographic of our CKCC congregational community

Over this weekend the Church Council, Elders, Staff and Ministers have met to reflect on what *spiritual leadership* looks like at CKCC and how we as leaders appointed by the congregation are able to build the congregation in faith and love, sustain members in hope and lead members into a fuller participation in Christ's mission in the world.
